

Proposed Solar Project in Amherst County, VA

Situated east of Patrick Henry Highway, this 50 MW solar facility seeks to revitalize a brownfield through a multi-use operation consisting of solar, sheep grazing, and pollinator meadows.

Why Piney River Solar is Good for Amherst County:



Will generate nearly **\$10 million** in tax revenue over its lifetime.

(s) Will incorporate a one-time siting agreement payment of \$2.4 million to the \square county to be used at the discretion of Amherst County.



Will establish a \$30,000 annual community fund focused on supporting Amherst County non-profits



Will create **200 well-paying jobs** during construction across civil, mechanical, electrical, and landscaping industries, while providing a boost to local hospitality businesses.



The project will be effectively screened from nearby neighbors and recreational amenities


